The better your goods are packed the faster and more securely they will reach the consignee. Our little packing guide will give you a few useful hints on how you can make sure your parcels are well packed.

We ensure that your goods reach the consignee reliably and fast. What you have to take care of in advance is easily explained and quickly done.

Packing Rules

- Contact information about the Shipper and the Consignee (including company names, addresses, contact phones, contact names) is to be clearly shown on the shipment.
- Packaging is to be undamaged, clean and dry ensuring no access to content.
- Packaging is to conform to the weight and type of content (providing safety of content and safety of other shipments).
- Bundled shipments are not accepted for carriage.
- All enclosures are to be packed tightly.
- Old parcel labels need to be removed from the package.
- Packaging with dangerous goods signs are not accepted.
- Shipments requiring special handling conditions are to carry appropriate labels on the packaging.
- Parcels packed in soft packaging are not accepted for carriage. Documents need to be packed in cardboard envelopes.
